

Submission of Camera Read Paper and Copyright Transfer via CMT Portal

Instructions:

Step 1 - Prepare Your Final Paper as per IEEE Template with minimum (4) to maximum (6) number of pages is required in standard IEEE format.

(<https://www.ieee.org/content/dam/ieee-org/ieee/web/org/conferences/conference-template-a4.docx>)

Please go through this video and prepare your camera-ready paper carefully.

Step 2 – Check your Final Paper

Please double check the information that you provide during online submission: Once submitted, it can't be changed later.

- Title of the paper
- Name, affiliation, e-mail address of the authors
- Name of the corresponding author
- Formatting is not strictly as per the IEEE format that was shared with the authors (attached herewith as well).
- Authors' names in the paper have salutations (Ms. Mr. Mrs. Dr., etc.) or designation (Prof., Dean , etc.). Writing salutations and designations are not allowed in the paper.

Step 3: Ensure the Similarity Index (Plagiarism Report) should be less than 30% Including References and any single source of plagiarism should not be more than 5%.

- Maintain minimum 15 references in the paper
- Incorporate the correction suggested by the reviewer. Please check the mail attachment.

- Run a Spellcheck and proofread your paper thoroughly to ensure that it contains no typo and grammatical errors. There are typographical and/or grammatical issues in the paper (totally unacceptable).
- Include good quality figures/graphics
- Tables must be drawn in table format, not as an image.
- In-text description and callouts for all the figure numbers, table numbers and equation numbers must be present in the paper as per the order of their occurrence
- Citation of all the references must be done inside the paper, that is, in-text citations.
- In-text citations must match their corresponding reference listed under the references section and vice-versa.
- Citation must be in ascending order, not in random manner
- Reference should not be cited in Abstract and Conclusion part.
- Remove words like “Our/we/us” from the paper

Step 4 – Check Copyright information (footer) and name of the conference (header) has been present in the first page of the paper or not

- If you’ve prepared your paper as per template (Step 1), then both header and footer have already been inserted. Otherwise, the appropriate copyright notice is to appear on the bottom of the first page of each paper according to the guidelines set forth for an IEEE Conference Publication. When preparing your final paper for submission, please remember to add the applicable copyright notice, found below for this conference, to the bottom of the first page of your final paper in the footer (font: Times New Roman, size:10, Left Aligned). This step should be completed before creating the PDF of your final paper.

- Add the sponsors, if needed, in the `\thanks{}` command of the authors definition

Step 5 - Check and submit your Final camera-ready Paper via PDF Express

- Use PDF eXpress to verify the PDF file of the paper for IEEE-compliance before submission. *Papers that are not IEEE-compliant will not be included in the proceedings nor published. To do it, follow the steps given below*
- Log in to the IEEE PDF eXpress TM site (Link: <https://ieeepdfexpress.org/>)
- Select "Create account". (Already existing users can directly login)
- Enter the following information:

59181X for the Conference ID

- Your email address.
- A password.
- Continue to enter information as prompted.

- An online confirmation will be displayed and an email confirmation will be sent verifying your account setup.
- Upload your file to convert to pdf format using following steps.
 - Login
 - For each conference paper, click “Create New Title” button, located in the Dashboard.
 - Enter the title of your submission in the field provided and then click either “Submit PDF for Checking” or “Submit Source File(s) for Conversion”.
 - The next screen will allow you to upload your file.
 - After uploading, you will receive online and email confirmation of the successful upload.
 - You will receive an email with your Checked PDF or IEEE PDF eXpress- converted PDF attached.
 - If you submitted a PDF for Checking, the email will show if your file passed or failed.
 - If PDF is passed, you will find a option "Approve". Also click on Download. Click to complete the process after renaming it as per instruction give below.
 - Never submit a revision to an existing title by clicking “Create New Title”.
- Revising your submission in the PDF eXpress site (if required):
 - Click on the “Try Again” link for the paper you want to change. Remember that you may submit either a PDF or source file(s), until you reach the maximum PDF Checks/Source File Conversions, for that title.

Step 5 – Click on “Approve”

Do not forget to click on "Approve". Once you click "Approve", the papers will be automatically accessible by the organizers.

Step 6 – Click on “Download PDF” then rename the PDF generated/checked

Also download the PDF and Download the PDF and rename the file as PID<Your CMT Paper ID>. pdf ; for example for paper id 678, the filename will be PID678.pdf

Step 7 – To fill Electronic Copyright Form (ECF)

- i. When you log-in to your CMT portal (<https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/ICRISST2024/>), you will see an option, 'Create Camera Ready Submission' against your paper ID. You need to upload two files here, 1) Your camera-ready paper, 2) IEEE Copyright form.
- ii. You will see another option under Camera Ready i.e. 'Submit IEEE Copyright Form'. Click on that and follow the process. Once the copyright form is generated (PDF file), do not forget to upload it under this section only. It is mandatory to transfer the copyright of your paper to IEEE for publication.
- iii. Please DO NOT use the Edit Submission Option on your author console on CMT.

The authors need to complete this on and before Feb 15 2024.
